2024 SYDNEY ROYAL EASTER SHOW

The Sydney Royal Easter Show (Show) is the largest, annual ticketed event in Australia, and is the main fundraising event hosted by the **Royal Agricultural Society of NSW (RAS)**. The RAS is purposed to forge the future of Australian agriculture by engaging, educating and entertaining our community on the value of sustainable agriculture and quality produce, accomplished through events that support agricultural excellence and innovation.

Revenue generated by the Show allows the RAS to invest in agriculture, education scholarships, youth programs, competitions, and in rural development in NSW. In total, the RAS invests \$11 million annually in these initiatives, which are designed to promote agricultural excellence and to keep our rural communities strong. We understand that when rural Australia benefits, all Australians benefit!

The origins of the Show date back to 1822, when the emphasis was on agriculture and food provision for the new colony. In the words of the early RAS Founders, they needed to band together, to help each other.

As the crowds converge at the Show each year, this is the real backdrop to what is happening. MEDIA ACCESS TO VENUES

All requests for access to the Main Arena must be directed through the Media Centre. All media in the Main Arena must wear a white coat (provided by the Media Centre) and broad-brimmed hat or cap (provided by the individual). Under no circumstances are media allowed to enter the Main Arena during a Grand Parade or the evening entertainment program.

All requests for access to Schmidt Arena, Ugly Fish Woodchop Stadium, and the Amphitheatre must be directed to the Media Centre.

ACCESS FOR TV CREWS

TV crews requiring onsite vehicle access for live-crosses and filming must advise the Media Centre, **at least 2 hours** in advance, where possible, every time they wish to enter Sydney Showground. TV crews arriving at the Showground unannounced will not be admitted by Security. Crew cars and link trucks ONLY will be provided with on-site parking.

A limited number of media parking spaces are available daily in P1. Exchange your P1 parking ticket for a validated parking pass at the media centre but please note parking is available on a first-in basis.



This year marks 125 years since Woodchop & Sawing competitions first appeared at the Show.

COMPETITION HIGHLIGHTS

Sydney Royal Easter Show competitions are run by the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW in fulfillment of its pledge to forge the future of Australian agriculture. Sydney Royal competitions set the benchmark for agricultural industry excellence and drive innovation with independent, expert judges presiding.

SYDNEY ROYAL WOODCHOPPING AND SAWING COMPETITION

The Sydney Royal Woodchopping and Sawing Competition welcomes competitors from 12 years of age (up to 17) in the Junior Classes, Veterans aged 60 years+, World Championships, Open Events, Mixed (often husband and wife), Male, and Ladies-only events, along with grading according to ability and experience.

This year marks 125 years since Woodchop & Sawing competitions first appeared at the Show. Promising world-class action, the Sydney Royal Woodchopping & Sawing Competition is the only competition in Australia to host five world title events including crowd favourite, the 325mm Tree Felling contest.

In what has traditionally been a maledominated sport, 2024 has more women entrants than ever before, making up 20% of woodchoppers on the lawn. For the first time at the Sydney Royal, two Women's World Championship titles are being held in 2024:

- 325mm Women's World Championship Sawing Content (Single Handed), and
- 275mm Women's World Championship Underhand.

THE ELDERS SYDNEY ROYAL BEEF CATTLE SHOW

The Elders Sydney Royal Beef Cattle Show welcomes up to 15 breeds of beef cattle to compete and attracts competitors from across Australia. Beef Cattle will be on site at the Show from Friday 22 March - Tuesday 26 March.

The most prestigious awards begin with the Beef Championships from 12.00pm on Monday, 25 March: The Urquhart Trophy is awarded to the Supreme Beef Exhibit from both Grand Champion Males and Females in all beef breeds. The RAS Supreme Interbreed Heifer is awarded to the Supreme Heifer (under 20 months). The Hordern Trophy is awarded to the best pair consisting of the Grand Champion Male and Female of each breed.

THE SYDNEY ROYAL DAIRY CATTLE SHOW

A full and strong udder is a must... the judges are looking for cows that can really display lots of milk. They like to see nice legs and feet that can walk long distances. But they also want well-attached udders and nice feet placement. At the Sydney Royal Easter Show, the best of the best dairy cattle in Australia are on display and ready for assessment.

This year, the Sydney Royal Dairy Cattle Show will host an International Judge and welcome six breeds of Dairy Cattle. FEATURE BREED DAIRY: The feature breed in 2024 is the Brown Swiss. Most historians agree that the Brown Swiss are the oldest of all the dairy breeds, originating in Switzerland, which is known as a cheese producing country-think fondue! Milk producers throughout the world are adding Brown Swiss to their herds because of the good milk, protein and butter fat. Brown Swiss milk is coveted by cheese makers.

Australian Merino's account for the majority of the world's merino wool, so naturally, competition at the Sydney Royal Sheep Show is fierce.

Merino and Poll Merino (no horns) are judged separately in this premier competition, with judges examining visual characteristics, fleece type,

weight, and even performing ultrasound scanning to determine muscle and fat depth.

The Grand Champion Rams and Grand Champion Ewes are then brought together to determine the Supreme Exhibit and winner of the RAS of NSW Supreme Merino Perpetual Trophy. FEATURE BREED: This year's feature breed is Poll Merino. Very strong, hardy animals, Poll Merino are considered dual purpose sheep, raised for both meat and wool production, but they are especially good for wool production. They are easy to care for, producing fleece that is epitomised by soft handling and good colour.

The central component of the ADVANCE™ Sydney Royal Dog Show is the breed judging, where our canine friends are assessed on their temperament, general appearance, features, height, weight, and colour in accordance with the Australian National Breed Standards. All breeds are assessed by highly qualified judges, with three international judges joining the ranks this year from Finland, Switzerland and Canada.

But it doesn't stop at breed judging! There is plenty of action at the judging

lawns, including the Obedience Trialsfrom novice through to master, and the Agility Competition--where dogs compete to be the fastest and most flawless through a series of obstacles.

THE SYDNEY ROYAL PIG COMPETITION

The Sydney Royal Pig Competition is one of the largest and most prestigious Pig Shows in Australia, celebrating and showcasing the successes of Australian Breeding Studs. Held at the first Sydney Royal Easter Show in 1858, the pig competition has been held at nearly every show since.

In 2017, a Commercial Competition for schools was introduced. In conjunction with sponsor Australian Pork Ltd, the Schools Commercial Competition aims to educate school students about the growing of commercial pigs and the commercial pig industry. In this competition, the Judge is reviewing a commercial pig, as opposed to the stud pigs, and are looking for exhibits that meet the breed standards of the specific heritage stud pig breed, valuing the traditions of genetic breeding and trueness to bloodlines.

FEATURE BREED: The Feature Breed in 2024 is the Landrace Pig. There are 8 pure breeds of pig in Australia, the Landrace pigs are the ones with lop ears that droop and slant forward. They are also recognisable for their looong body. They have white skin, are free of black hair, and are noted for the ability to farrow and raise large litters. The breed was originally developed in Denmark and were imported into Australia from New Zealand and Great Britain between 1959 and 1973.

THE SYDNEY ROYAL ANGORA GOAT & MOHAIR COMPETITION

The Sydney Royal Angora Goat & Mohair Competition is the largest and most prestigious in Australia, held in our world class venue, the Paddington Pavilion.

The competition aims to celebrate and showcase the success of Breeding Studs by allowing them the chance to compete and receive feedback from knowledgeable and experienced Judges, with the added benefit of public exposure to their animals and studs.

As one of the oldest domesticated

animals in the world, goats are bred for milk, fleece and meat production, depending on the breed. Each breed also has their own unique characteristics-goats dislike water and would rather leap over streams and puddles than step in them, while Miniature Goats are affectionate creatures and make awesome pets!

Exhibitors who compete at the Sydney Royal Angora Goat & Mohair Show are often from small family-based Stud farms who uphold and value the traditions of genetic breeding and trueness to bloodlines, which is what the judges will focus on, whether judging the animal itself, or a shorn fleece.

SYDNEY ROYAL ALPACA COMPETITION

In 1869 Alpacas were first judged at the Show – in the sheep competition! In 1870 their fleece was judged in the wool section, in 1882 they were judged in the dog section, but at last in 1992 alpacas were placed in their own competition and have been showing strongly and growing in popularity ever since.

Alpacas are assessed on their bone structure, proportion and their balance, whilst their fleece is judged on density, lustre and character. Alpaca fleece is quite luxurious and silky, making the softest of baby blankets, lightweight shawls and classic cardigans and coats.

FEATURE BREED: The feature breed for 2024 is the Modern Game, a breed of ornamental chicken that originated in England between 1850 and 1900. The small Modern Game, measuring only 25cm tall, also called bantams, are said to have the finesse of a ballerina. Perfectly suited to small backyards and limited spaces, they are very quiet and happy to be held.

SYDNEY ROYAL FLOWER & GARDEN SHOW

Until 2007 this competition was known as Horticulture, a competition that has been held at the Show every year since 1929. However, 1929 wasn't the first appearance of gatherings from the garden, in 1869 silkworms were judged along with sugar cane and tobacco in 1871, and even salads in 1875. In 1929 the competition became one predominantly of 'flowering and other plants' although fish and aquariums were entered in 1957-1959.

Today the competition looks at cut flowers, cacti & succulents, fruit and vegetables with four special classes in flower arranging this year - Period Design (heritage), Traditional Design, European Design, and Contemporary Design. The Judges are looking for perfect blooms, well-kept and tidy plants, and creative arrangements.

SUSTAINABILITY AT THE SHOW

SYDNEY SHOWGROUND ESG INITIATIVES

Sydney Showground is the venue and event management business of the RAS, channelling all revenues raised back into the RAS' community work. Its pinnacle event is the annual Sydney Royal Easter Show, attracting nearly 850,000 people annually over 12 days.

What Sydney Showground offers the community in terms of engagement, is very special, and it goes beyond just having a good time.

Sydney Showground has recently adopted an Environmental, Social & Governance (ESG) Initiatives policy. Darryl Jeffery, General Manager of Sydney Showground, explains, "organisers who hire Showground spaces want to know that what they're doing, and the money they're spending in the venue, is being used the right way."

Sustainability and environmental impacts are core to ESG initiatives. Sydney Showground's lighting and air conditioning across the venue has been upgraded. Real-time impact measurements have shown that carbon emissions dropped by 70 tonnes in the first year since the upgrade, and by 50 tonnes in the second.


That's a total of 120 tonnes over two years—the equivalent of charging 14 million smartphones.

This is the kind of community impact and ESG measures that organisers are looking for, and which Showground is now able to provide.

WOODCHOPPING

The RAS has partnered with Managed Waste Services (MWS) to provide a sustainable, innovative solution for stable waste and chopped wood at the 2024 Sydney Royal Easter Show resulting in a 100% resource recovery.

Once chopped during the Sydney Royal Woodchop competition, the used wood will be transported to the North West Recycling Centre and processed into a fine mulch. This is achieved by mulching the wood and placing it in water so the metal (from nails used during woodchop) sink to the bottom and separate. The end product is then converted into poultry bedding for use by poultry farmers.



FAST FACTS

These facts and figures have been developed to give you at-a-glance information about the Royal Agricultural Society of NSW (RAS).

- The first Sydney Royal Easter Show was run at Parramatta Showground in 1823
- The Sydney Royal Easter Show welcomes over 850,000 attendees on average. The highest recorded attendance was in 1998, when the Show moved to Sydney Olympic Park for the first time, the attendance that year was 1,262,339.
- On average 15,000 trophies, certificates and medals are awarded during the Show, across over 22,000 entries.
- Livestock competitions welcome over 6,500 livestock exhibits on average each year, with those competitions representing over 480 different animal breeds.
- The RAS represents far more than the world-famous Sydney Royal Easter Show, it is the over-arching body for all events held across the 30-hectare Sydney Showground site year-round.
- The RAS generates a total economic contribution in excess of \$617 million towards the New South Wales economy each year.
- The RAS Foundation has invested more than \$8.17 million into country NSW through a range of targeted grants and scholarships.
- The RAS engages with over 3,500 schools to deliver education resources to teach young people about food origins, food security and career pathways into agriculture.
- Sydney Royal competitions attract over 35,000 entries recognising the best of the best including Sydney Royal Easter Show exhibits, and Wine, Dairy and Fine Food competitions held across the calendar year.
- The RAS' Australasian Animal Registry (AAR) is the largest not-for-profit animal registration and recovery service in Australasia, currently maintaining the **records of more than 2 million animals**.
