

Terms & Conditions & Conditions of Sale for School Program Tickets for the 2026 Sydney Royal Easter Show ('SRES')

Conditions of use

The Royal Agricultural Society of NSW ('RAS') trading as the Sydney Royal Easter Show ('SRES') is responsible for the website (www.eastershow.com.au). Ticketmaster Australasia Pty Ltd (ABN: 49 089 258 837) is responsible for the sale of Tickets to the 2026 SRES.

By clicking 'Accept', you agree that you have read and understand the following terms and conditions which apply to your purchase of Schools Program Tickets:

1. Purchase of School Tickets and Sessions are strictly available to 'Schools' which are defined as NSW and ACT public schools and/or any school which appears within the following lists:

2. These Terms and Conditions apply to both the original purchaser and any subsequent ticketholders.

3. The RAS may amend these Terms and Conditions from time to time by publishing the updated version on it's website. Any variations will only apply to ticket purchases made after the Terms and Conditions have been updated. It is your responsibility to review and ensure that you agree and accept the most updated Terms and Conditions.

Ticketing

4. Student Tickets:
 - a. The School agrees to pay on behalf of each student attending the SRES through the Schools Program.
 - b. This Student ticket must be used for entry on the day the student attends with the school group.
 - c. A student ticket for a Schools Program Ticket is twenty dollars (\$20.00) per student and is GST-exempt ("Student Ticket Fee").
 - d. This Teacher ticket must be used for entry on the day the Teacher attends with the school group.
 - e. A Teacher ticket for a Schools Program Ticket is twenty dollars (\$20.00) per teacher and is GST-inclusive.
5. Home-school Tickets:
 - a. Home-school tickets can only be purchased by large groups exceeding ten (10) students.
6. The school / ticketholder must not resell, or offer for resale, tickets or vouchers for profit or commercial gain. If this occurs, the ticket holder will be refused entry and the ticket will be cancelled. Ticket sale legislation can impose criminal penalties.
7. The registration received via email after purchase are the tickets for entry. We kindly request that you provide this as proof of ticket purchase upon arrival. Failure to bring this registration as proof of ticket purchase may result in in failure to attend the SRES.

8. The RAS reserves the right to not issue replacements for lost, stolen, damaged or destroyed tickets.
9. Tickets must be kept in a good condition as the RAS may refuse entry for damaged or defaced tickets.
10. Tickets will not be issued until Ticketmaster has received full payment from the school. Completion of payment is a condition precedent to the release of tickets. Ticketmaster accepts payment by the following methods: -
 - Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT);
 - Credit cards.
11. By submitting payment on this website, the buyer confirms they are either the authorised card holder or has the express consent of the cardholder. RAS will not accept returns, exchanges or refunds unless required by law or at the RAS' sole discretion.
12. Tickets are non-transferable and can only be used for the booked date.
13. The RAS reserves the right to change the advertised program, price, venue, access to certain areas or reschedule the SRES, at its sole discretion.
14. Unless required by law, the RAS will not be liable for any other losses incurred by the school / ticketholder as a result of the cancellation, rescheduling or relocation of the SRES including any travel and accommodation expenses.
15. Without limiting other remedies it may have, the RAS may limit, cancel, suspend, or refuse entry to school / ticketholder who are acting inconsistently with these Terms and Conditions or the Conditions of Entry to the Sydney Showground. Entry is subject to the Conditions of Entry to Sydney Showground, full conditions of entry are available at www.eastershow.com.au.
16. Teacher Pack and Forms.
 - a. The school / ticketholder must complete all required documentation prior to the SRES. Required documents include, but are not limited to, the Teacher Pack and all forms in the Teacher Pack.

- b. The RAS will not be liable for, and the school / ticketholder agrees to hold the RAS harmless, for any inaccurate and incomplete forms.

As part of the school / ticketholder participation at the SRES, unless otherwise expressly specified in any document or form submitted by the school / ticketholder, the school / ticketholder gives permission to be photographed and filmed by the RAS and agrees that the photograph and film may be used at the RAS, at its discretion, in print, television, online, and in social media channels. The school / ticketholder agrees to obtain the necessary consents/permissions for the photography of participants in the SRES.
